

WHAT TO EXPECT ON TOURNAMENT DAY

As you approach the event on Curtiss Wright Parkway, you will be directed by people holding flags to the southeast corner of the field. Once there, you will be asked to pay a \$5.00 parking fee (trying to reduce the # of cars) and then directed to drive into the event to the grass parking area. Please note the open field next to the parking area is used for rugby and cricket, and is not to be driven on.

After parking, you will be directed to the entrance where you will proceed to the waiver form table. Everyone entering the event must sign a waiver, regardless of whether they are playing. A colored wristband will then be issued and is to be worn at all times.

The next stop will be to obtain a second colored wristband (for those wanting consume beer) by proceeding to the police checkpoint where valid ID's must be presented.

Team Captains will then proceed to the registration table to pick up your T-Shirts and raffle tickets. Only the team captain will be given the package (He or she will be the one listed on the registration form). Make sure you know the name of your team.

You can also visit our information table, which will be located next to the registration table. Around noon the information table will be relocated inside the event and positioned next to the bridge.

Email confirmations were sent to all team captains (upon receipt of their registration forms) detailing starting times and court assignments. The information table will have that information if you are not sure.

Although we will take registrations as late as the day of the event, any form received after the July 5th deadline WILL NOT RECEIVE a T-Shirt.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING

Several people have complained about the parking fee. I don't like the policy either, but I have to do something to cut down on the number of cars entering the event. When damage is done to the fields, I have to pay to fix it.

Additionally, in order to sell beer, I have to apply for a permit from the State of Ohio. It clearly states that no other alcohol other than what is sold at the event is permitted inside the fenced in area. If an inspector from the state should appear that day and see other alcohol, the event could be terminated immediately.

While we know many participants have special food and beverage needs, we ask that you support our food and beverage vendors and not bring in coolers.
